1. Discuss the provisions relating to special defences to murder as provided in the exceptions 1 to 5 to Section 300 IPC. What are the bases for such special provisions when the Penal Code has already provided the General exceptions to cover the cases of exemptions from criminal liability? 16

What is rape? Is consent a defence to a charge of rape? If so, under what circumstances a person may be acquitted of the charge of rape on the ground of consent? Discuss with case laws. 16

2. Write distinctions between the following :
(any two) 8×2=16

- (a) Criminal trespass and house trespass
- (b) Criminal misappropriation and criminal breach of trust
- (c) Forgery and cheating
- (d) Robbery and dacoity.

OR

"An offence of theft may become robbery; extortion may also become robbery; and robbery may become dacoity. It all depends upon the circumstances of each case. But one thing common therein is property involved in each case." Discuss in detail with appropriate examples and case laws.

3. Explain the meaning of the word "Public Servant" given in the IPC. Discuss the liability of a Public Servant disobeying law with intent to cause injury to any person.

Define the term 'bribery'. Under what circumstances a public servant is said to have committed the offence of corruption. Mention which provision of the IPC is omitted by the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, in regard to offences by or relating to a public servant.

4. Define what is Cyber Crime. What are the various kinds of Cyber Crime? What are the laws available in India to combat such types of crimes, where the offender is totally unknown to the victim?

What do you mean by hacking? Who is a hacker? Discuss the laws of hacking and criminal trespass. Write your answer mentioning the specific legislation dealing with hacking in India.

5. Give a brief account of the establishment and functioning of the Law Commission of India. How far the recommendations of the LCI are adhered to in successfully bringing about change in the Indian legal system? Discuss in detail.
