2. What is Food? Explain the term food adulteration.

Critically evaluate the factors and reasons of adulteration in food staffs with reference to the relevant provisions of the Food Adulteration Act, 1954.

Analyse critically the nature and objects of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955. What, according to you are the factors for which, the goals to be achieved by the Act, is not possible even after many amendments made to the Act?

3. Logically evaluate and assess the 29th report of the Law Commission of India. 16

Discuss in detail the trial and punishment of social and economic offences as envisaged in the 47th Report of the LCI.

4. Define 'dowry'. Differentiate between 'dowry' and 'Stridhan'.

Discuss some of the drawbacks, you find in the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

#### Or

Make an evaluation of the provisions of the Protection of Civil Rights Act, 1955 in terms of aims and objectives with which this Act was enacted.

5. Define the terms arms, ammunitions and fire arms. Analyse critically the provisions relating to licensees mentioned in the Arms Act, 1959.

#### Or

Discuss the powers of the Central Government and the State Governments to make orders for detaining certain persons mentioned in the National Security Act, 1960.

What is the maximum period of detention as provided in the Act and when the detention orders can be revoked in conjuction with the appropriate provisions of the Act of 1980? Discuss.
