1. What is Valid Consent under the Criminal law ? Discuss the relevant provisions of the I.P.C. in this respect. How does it relate with negligence ? Discuss.

“Theoretically, ignorance of fact being an excuse equally well should ignorance of law be an excuse for both negative the existence of a guilty mind”.

Explain the above statements stating the reason for the same.

Explain the Proximate and Remote causes of crime. Discuss the liability if any, in case of refusing to undergo treatment by the victim.

Or

Discuss the subjective as well as the objective theory of criminal liability, stating its specific application in the I.P.C.

"A crime would mean something more than a mere disobedience to a law". Critically explain the above statements.

Or

What are the distinctions between moral, civil and criminal wrongs? What are the specific tests of criminality? Discuss.

Modern author criticises the use of the term "inchoate" as misleading. Explain with reference to the relevant provisions of law in the I.P.C. How are the general exceptions applicable in case of such types of crimes? Explain.

Or

What do you mean by criminal conspiracy as given in the I.P.C.? What are its Kinds? Is there any difference between English Law and Indian Law in this respect? Discuss.

5. Discuss the difference between common intention and abetment citing illustrations. State the requirements for penalising an accused for an offence of abetment. Is there any effect of convicting or acquitting of a co-accused in case of abetment? Explain.

What are the differences between vicarious liability and strict liability in the criminal law? State the reasons behind the imposition of such liabilities. State also the distinctions between the section 154 and section 155 of the Indian Penal Code.
